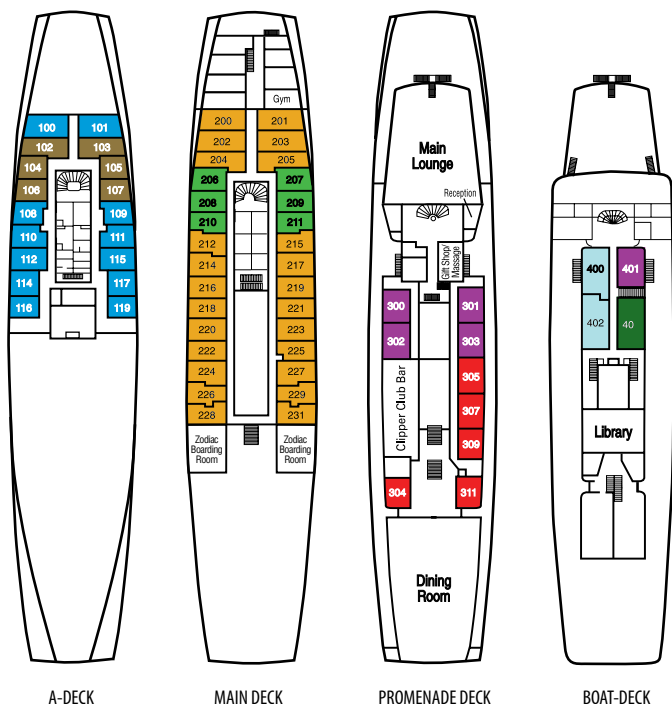

## THE CLIPPER ADVENTURER

The *Clipper Adventurer* is a superb oceangoing vessel equipped with stabilizers and an ice-hardened hull that allow her to navigate easily in the most rugged natural environments. The vessel is outfitted with satellite navigation and communication equipment. A fleet of Zodiac landing craft permits us to land anywhere nature or curiosity dictates. Each cabin has an ocean view, individually controlled heat/air conditioner, an in-room music system, and en suite bathroom. Facilities on board the *Clipper Adventurer* include a dining room, lounge, library, gift shop, infirmary, laundry, and small gym. **DETAILS ▶**

## THE CLIPPER ADVENTURER FACT SHEET



### GENERAL

---

- Four decks of passenger facilities.
  - Boat Deck – passenger cabins and the library.
  - Promenade Deck – passenger cabins, Clipper Club bar, dining room, main lounge, gift shop and reception.
  - Main Deck – passenger cabins, gym, and Zodiac boarding area.
  - A-Deck – passenger cabins.
- Stairs connect the decks (no elevator).
- The bridge is available to visit most times throughout the day, contingent upon weather and navigation conditions.
- Smoking is allowed on outside decks only.

### CABINS

---

- Twin cabins on Main and A-Deck are similar in amenities and average about 136 square feet; all cabins on Promenade Deck are slightly larger and average 165 square feet; suites are 211 square feet.
- All cabins have: a bathroom with shower, individually controlled heat/air conditioner, in-room music system, an intercom system for announcements, European-type outlets (two round sockets) at 220 volts, ample wardrobe space, full length mirrors, locked drawer, emergency buttons to call reception, desk and chair, and hair dryer.
- All cabins have two twin lower beds. A few triple cabins are available.
- Ocean view: cabins on A-Deck have two portholes, 12 inches in diameter; cabins 200–211 have one porthole, 12 inches in diameter; cabins 212–231 have one window, 24 inches by 17 inches; and cabins on Promenade Deck and the suites have one window, 22 inches by 16.5 inches.

### DINING

---

- The main dining room holds the full complement of passengers at one seating.
- Special dietary requests can be fulfilled with advance notice. Kosher meals are not available.
- A buffet lunch is available in the main lounge, and a full breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served in the dining room.

### SERVICES

---

- *Clipper Adventurer* carries a fleet of Zodiacs.
- Laundry services (no dry cleaning), a massage therapist, and a doctor and a small infirmary are all available on board. Rates are posted.
- A small gift shop carries a limited supply of necessities as well as ship gift items and arts/crafts of the regions visited.
- A gym and small library with books and games available for public use.
- Cash, personal checks, traveler's checks, MasterCard, and Visa are accepted as payment for services rendered on board.
- The U.S. dollar is the currency used on board.
