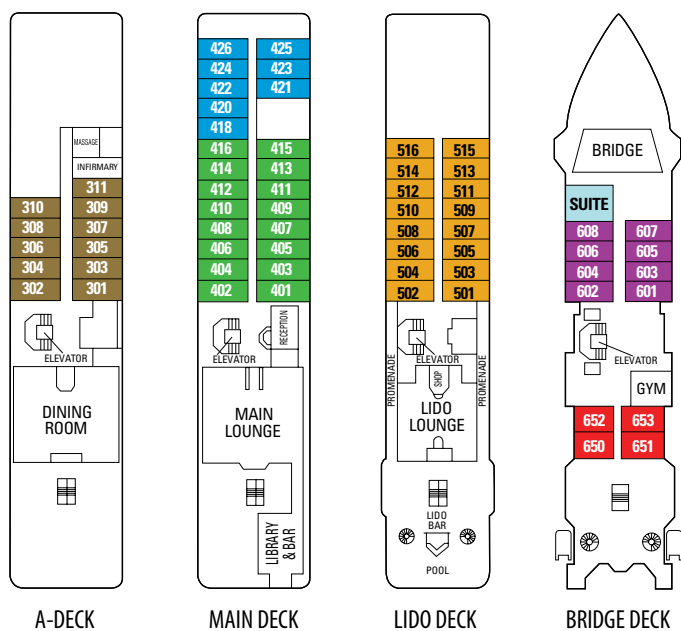

THE CLIPPER ODYSSEY

The *Clipper Odyssey* is a 110-passenger luxury expedition vessel. Facilities on board include 64 ocean-view cabins (all with private facilities), a dining room, lounge, small library and gym, outdoor pool, massage room, and gift shop. The *Clipper Odyssey* also carries a fleet of Zodiacs, which permits us to land anywhere nature or curiosity dictates. For expeditions in warm-weather regions, her glass-bottom boat gives us a topside-look at the undersea world.

THE CLIPPER ODYSSEY FACT SHEET



GENERAL

- Five decks of passenger facilities.
 - Sun Deck – wide open deck with a jogging track.
 - Bridge Deck – passenger cabins, gym and bridge.
 - Lido Deck – passenger cabins, Lido lounge, gift shop, Lido bar, and pool.
 - Main Deck – passenger cabins, reception, main lounge, and library/internet café.
 - A-Deck – passenger cabins, infirmary, massage room, and dining room.
- An elevator connects all decks.
- The bridge is available to visit most times throughout the day, contingent upon weather and navigation conditions.
- *Clipper Odyssey* is a nonsmoking ship. Smoking is allowed on outside decks only.

CABINS

- Cabins are similar in amenities and average about 186 square feet; one suite is available (308 square feet).
- All cabins have: sitting area with sofa, bathroom with tub and shower, individually controlled heat/air conditioner, American style outlets (two flat prongs) at 110 volts, in-room music system, an intercom system for announcements, ample wardrobe space, mirrors, personal safe, minibar/refrigerator, television, and hair dryer.
- All cabins have two twin lower beds that can be made into one queen bed.
- Ocean view: cabins on the A-Deck have two portholes, 16 inches in diameter; Main, Lido, and Bridge Deck cabins have one window, three feet by four feet; cabins 601–608 and the suite have balconies.

DINING

- The main dining room holds the full complement of passengers at one seating.
- Special dietary requests can be fulfilled with advance notice. Kosher meals are not available.
- A buffet breakfast and lunch are served in the Lido lounge, and a full breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served in the dining room.

SERVICES

- Snorkel gear is available for all passengers free of charge.
- Weight belts, weights, and tanks are available for certified divers on voyages where diving is offered and all necessary paperwork has been completed. All divers must bring any additional equipment. There may be a charge for diving services.
- *Clipper Odyssey* carries Zodiacs, a glass-bottom boat, and rescue boats.
- Laundry services (no dry cleaning) are available on board. There is also a small infirmary and doctor available, as well as a massage therapist on board. Rates are posted at reception.
- A gym, outdoor pool, and a library/internet café with books, games, and computers with internet access, are available for public use.
- A gift shop carries a limited supply of necessities as well as ship gift items.
- Cash, traveler's checks, MasterCard, and Visa are accepted as payment for services rendered on board.
- The U.S. dollar is the currency used on board.
