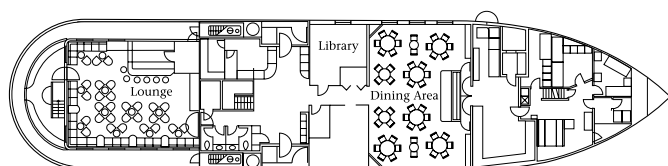


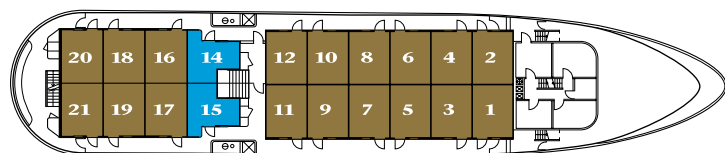

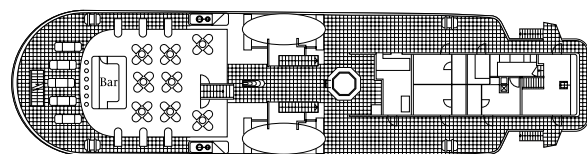

THE ISABELA II

The 40-guest *Isabela II* is one of the most luxurious yachts cruising the Galápagos. She is fully air-conditioned and has the amenities of a larger vessel, including a bar, dining room, and sun deck. The sun deck comprises a bar with ample outdoor seating, an observation area for whale and dolphin watching, a gym, Jacuzzi, and solarium. The *Isabela II* carries sea kayaks and three Zodiacs, and as an alternative to snorkeling, her glass-bottom boat offers a great opportunity to observe the marine life from above the waves. The library contains the largest variety of books on Galápagos and Ecuador of any ship in Galápagos waters, as well as excellent nature and conservation videos. **DETAILS ▶**

THE ISABELA II FACT SHEET



GENERAL

- Three decks of passenger facilities.
 - Main Deck – lounge, library, and dining room.
 - Cabin Deck – passenger cabins.
 - Sun Deck – Jacuzzi, bar, gym.
- Stairs (no elevator) service all decks.
- *Isabela II* allows bridge visits, contingent upon weather and navigation conditions.
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only.

CABINS

- All cabins are outside and have either two fixed twins or one fixed double bed, en-suite facilities, ample storage space, small safe, hair dryer, and individual air-conditioning control. Electrical outlets are 110 volts and take American-style flat pronged plugs.
- All cabins are located on the cabin deck and are approximately 140 square feet, with the exception of two smaller cabins for single passengers which are 120 square feet.

DINING

- Meals are served in the main dining room. Breakfast and lunch are served buffet-style and dinner is served at the table.
- Most diets can be catered for on board, but special dietary requests must be made in advance. Kosher diets cannot be accommodated.

SERVICES

- *Isabela II* carries Zodiacs, sea kayaks, and a glass bottom boat for passenger explorations.
- Public spaces include a lounge, solarium, small gym, bar, and library/reading room. There is free internet access on board.
- Snorkel gear and wet suits are provided for all passengers.
- There are no laundry facilities on board, but there will be the opportunity to send laundry out (no dry cleaning) once during the trip. Rates are available on board.
- There is a certified doctor on board. Rates for medical services will be posted.
- The U.S. dollar is the currency used on board. Ship accounts can be paid by traveler's check or Visa, MasterCard, and American Express.
