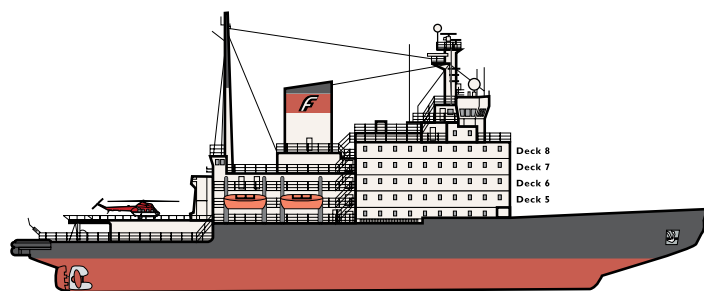
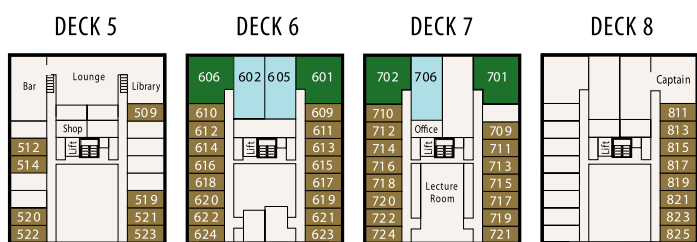

THE KAPITAN KHLBNIKOV

The *Kapitan Khlebnikov* was constructed in 1981 by the Warstsila Company, Finland, the world's leading builder of icebreakers. Not simply an ice-reinforced ship, the *Khlebnikov* is a powerful working icebreaker designed for the challenging conditions of frozen polar seas. The *Khlebnikov* was refurbished to accommodate passengers in 54 outside cabins and suites, all with en suite facilities. Cabins are spacious and comfortable. Public areas include a lounge, two dining rooms, digitally-equipped lecture room, small heated indoor pool and gymnasium, library, and sauna. Views are excellent from the bridge and large open decks. In addition to its fleet of Zodiacs, the *Khlebnikov* uses two helicopters for ice reconnaissance and passenger excursions. **DETAILS ▶**

THE KAPITAN KHLEBNIKOV FACT SHEET



GENERAL

- Six decks of passenger facilities.
 - Deck 3 – sauna, gym, and pool.
 - Deck 4 – dining rooms, doctor, and helicopter loading deck.
 - Deck 5 – passenger cabins, bar, lounge, library, and gift shop.
 - Deck 6 – passenger cabins and suites.
 - Deck 7 – passenger cabins, suites, and lecture room.
 - Deck 8 – passenger cabins.
- An elevator services all decks.
- The bridge is available to visit most times throughout the day, contingent upon weather and navigation conditions.
- Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. Smoking is prohibited inside the ship and on Zodiac and helicopter loading areas.

CABINS

- All cabins are outside with windows that can be opened for fresh air; private bathroom with shower, toilet, and wash-basin; ample cupboard and drawer space; and a large desk. Electrical outlets are 220 volts/50 hz and take European-style two round prong plugs.
- Each cabin has two lower beds, one of which is a sofa bed that will be made up for comfortable seating during the day.
- Standard cabins are approximately 135 square feet.
- All suites are approximately 285 square feet with a separated bedroom and living room. Corner suites have two large windows, one facing the side and one facing forward.

DINING

- There are two dining rooms on board. Breakfast is served buffet-style, while lunch and dinner have table service.
- Most diets can be catered for on board with special dietary requests made in advance. However, kosher meals cannot be provided.
- Coffee and tea are available 24 hours a day, and pastries are served in the afternoon.

SERVICES

- *Kapitan Khlebnikov* carries a fleet of Zodiacs and two helicopters for both ice-reconnaissance and passenger excursions.
- Public spaces include a lecture room, bar, lounge, and library.
- Additional amenities include a sauna, small exercise room, indoor pool, and onboard shop carrying logo items, postcards, drug store items, and film.
- There is laundry service (no dry cleaning) and a small medical clinic. Prices will be available on board.
- The U.S. dollar is the currency used on board.
- Shipboard accounts can be paid by cash, traveler's check, or major credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Diners Club).
