

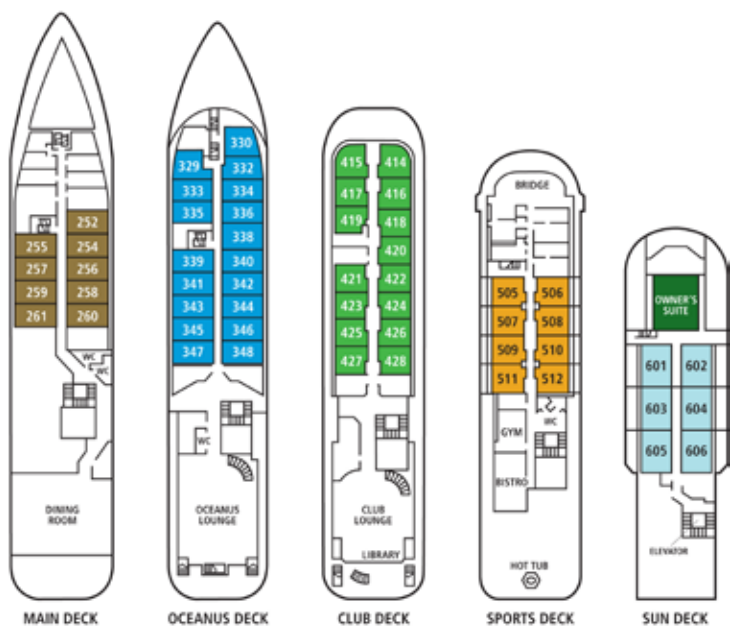

The Sea Spirit

Built in 1991 and recently refurbished, the *Sea Spirit* is a spacious, yet intimate, expedition vessel. Public spaces available include two lounges, library stocked with fiction and reference books and computers with Internet access, a hair salon, small gym, and a single sitting dining room. Outside decks feature a sun deck, hot tub, and bistro where meals are served in pleasant weather. For excursions ashore, the *Sea Spirit* carries a fleet of inflatable landing crafts, and bridge visits allow for the chance to see her expert officers and crew at work.

SEA SPIRIT FACT SHEET



GENERAL

- Five decks of passenger facilities.
 - Main Deck – Main passenger cabins, restaurant, and infirmary.
 - Oceanus Deck – Classic passenger cabins, Oceanus Lounge, reception.
 - Club Deck – Superior passenger cabins, Club Lounge, library.
 - Sports Deck – Deluxe passenger cabins, Bistro, gym, bridge, hot tub.
 - Sun Deck – Passenger Suites, Owner's Suite, and sun deck.
- Stairs and an elevator service all decks.
- The bridge is available to visit most times throughout the day, contingent upon weather, security, and navigation conditions.
- Smoking is permitted only on outside decks.

CABINS

All cabins feature ocean views and have two twin beds that can be reconfigured into one queen, a sitting area with sofa bed, en suite bathroom, large wardrobes, vanity table, small refrigerator, television, personal safe, hair dryer, assorted toiletries, individually controlled air-conditioning and heating, and American-style outlets (two flat prongs) at 110 volts.

- Main cabins are an average of 230 square feet with a minimum of two portholes.
- Classic cabins are an average of 250 square feet featuring a picture window.
- Superior cabins are an average of 235 square feet featuring a large picture window and walk-in closet.
- Deluxe cabins are an average of 277 square feet featuring a sliding glass door leading to a private balcony.
- Suites are an average of 353 square feet featuring a sliding glass door leading to a private balcony.
- Owner's Suite is approximately 800 square feet and features a large sliding glass doors leading to a private balcony

DINING

- The main restaurant can accommodate all passengers at one seating.
- Most diets (except Kosher) can be accommodated, but special dietary requests must be made in advance.
- When weather permits, lunch can be served on deck, but is usually served in the main restaurant with a self-serve soup and salad option. Dinner is also served in the main restaurant.
- Afternoon tea is served in the Oceanus Lounge and coffee and tea are available 24 hours a day in the Club Lounge.

SERVICES

- The *Sea Spirit* carries a fleet of inflatable landing crafts and a small tender.
- Public spaces include two lounges and library with games, reference books, novels, and computers with limited Internet access.
- Laundry services (no dry cleaning) and a small doctor's office are available on board. Rates are posted.
- U.S. dollars is the currency used on board. Traveler's checks, Visa, Mastercard, and American Express are accepted for payment of shipboard accounts
